


Figure.1: Ethnic traditional sports cultural resources, shown as a Venn diagram, using weak association data mining




Figure.2: National sports data flow diagram for cultural preservation efforts




Figure.3 Involvement of Platform Development in terms of Percentages.





Figure.4 Involvement of Traditional Sports in terms of Percentages.






Figure.5 Involvement of Focus of User Engagement in Terms of Percentages.




Figure.6 Involvement of Prioritize Access and Connectivity

Access and Connectivity prioritizes Mobile App Development (45%), followed by Web Portal Development (30%) and Offline Integration (25%) show in Fig.6
